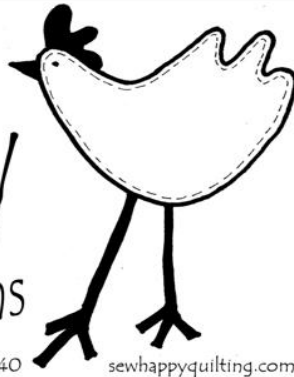

## Summer Shop Hops

We are will be participating in 2 Shop Hops this summer. The Mini Shop hop in August for our local shops and then the Mystery Harvest Shop hop in October. Plan a little get-away and stop by the shop for great deals and original quilt designs.

The Mini Shop Hop will be Friday, August 6th & Saturday, August 7th. The shops will be open from 10-6 on Friday and 10-5 on Saturday. Each shop will be designing a row in a Row Quilt — Signs of Fall. Our row is a 60" wide row of 6" & 12" maple leaves. The six shops participating in this hop are Woolen Willow in Williamstown, Quilters Corner in Marietta, Neff's Country Loft in Belpre, Parkersburg Sewing Center in Parkersburg, Pieces of the Past in Harrisville and Sew Happy Quilting Traditions in Little Hocking.

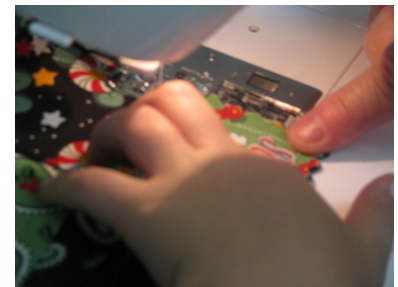
## Shop Events

### Baby Doll Blanket — Kids Class!! — June 29 10:30-3:30

Does your little one want to learn how to sew? Sign them up for a Kids Class. In the class, we will make a baby doll blanket (top only). All fabric will be precut into strips and then the child will sew the strips together in a random order. This will teach them basic eye/hand/foot coordination. They will also learn how to pin the fabric strips together, how to use the iron carefully, and how to sew a proper seam allowance. Once the top is done, we will help them put a back on it to finish it. This project will be approximately 18x24 — the perfect size for their favorite doll.

Class fee: \$15.00.

Class size is limited so sign up early to reserve your spot.



### Aunt Philly's Toothbrush Rug — June 26

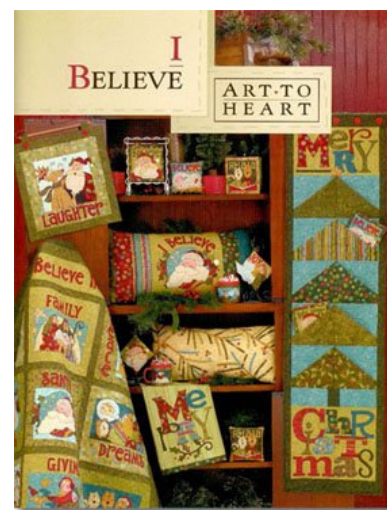
We are sew happy to have Carmen Grudier, a certified Toothbrush Rug teacher. Class fee: \$45.00 plus supplies.

We will also be continuing with our table topper of the month club by *Cotton Way* at the same time.

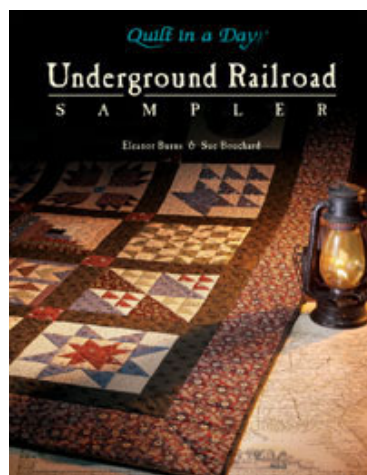


### I Believe Applique Quilt Block of the Month

### Underground Railroad Block of the Month

June 17, July 1, July 15, & July 29 10:30-3:30

Work on an Underground Railroad quilt following one of Eleanor Burn's best selling books. Learn how 15 quilt blocks may have played a significant role in the lives of slaves and how it helped them on their way to freedom. This class has been a huge hit and we have plenty of room for more to join. We are working at your own pace and will help you start whenever you would like.

Class fee: \$12.50 per block.

### Beginning Quilting — June 10 & 26, July 13 10:30-3:30

Finish the Yellow Brick Road Quilt by Atkinson Designs in as few as 2 sessions. This class will teach you basic rotary cutting, ironing, & how to follow the directions. Quilt is approximately 45x55. Class fee: \$10.00 plus supplies.



### Interchangeable Purse — June 8 & July 6 10:30-3:30



Come in and make this adorable purse using 3 fat quarters.

The handle can be removed & a new bag put on. Class fee: \$10.00 plus cost of kit.

### Long May She Wave Redwork Quilt — June 15 10:30-3:30

Learn how to embroidery during the first class. Finish the redwork center on your own. Come back in June to finish this great patriotic wallhanging.

Class fee: \$10.00 plus the cost of your kit.

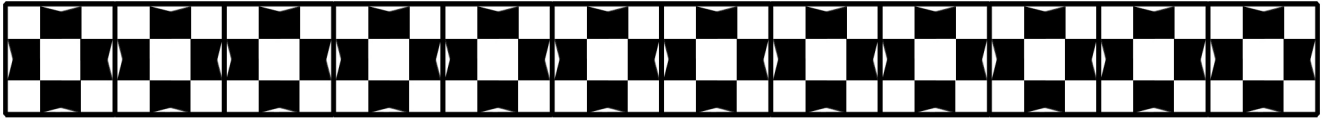
We are also working on several other redwork projects at the shop. Work on any of these as well!!

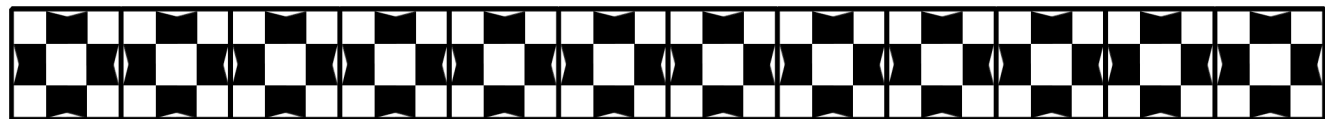

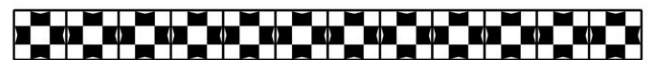
New members are welcome!! Annual yearly dues are \$15.00. The next meeting is July 10th.
